Syracuse Community Solar is a partnership between the City of Syracuse and EnergySmart CNY, Central New York's Regional Clean Energy Hub. The program connects Syracuse residents and businesses to an official Community Solar provider, Solar Simplified, to subscribe to local solar farms and receive monthly savings on utility bills.

HOW IT WORKS



Solar Credits = Share of energy produced by a solar farm

Solar farms are installed regionally. New York State requires new solar farms receiving state funding to provide solar credits to subscribed participants at a discounted rate.



You access the discounted energy through subscription to the solar farm. Your utility provider stays the same.



Discounted energy from regional solar farms is transferred through National Grid to your building.



Subscribers receive solar credits on their electric bill, then pay for those credits at a discounted value, lowering your total electrical supply and delivery charges on your utility bill.

HOW YOU SAVE MONEY

You receive solar credits, reducing your electricity charges for demand and supply

You only pay for those credits at a set rate of 90% of their value, or 80% if you're income-qualified

You keep the remaining 10% or 20% of the savings, lowering your total electrical bill

If there are no solar credits applied, there will be no payment of those credits on the bill



Guaranteed savings on your electricity costs



No cost, no additional fees, and no long-term contracts
