- III. Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m.
- IV. Approval of Minutes:

Mr. Steven Kulick made a motion to accept the minutes of the February 22, 2021, meeting of the City Planning Commission. Mr. Walter Bowler seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

- V. Discussion
 - 1) ReZone Syracuse Update

Mr. Dan Kwasnowski, Director of the Syracuse-Onondaga County Planning Agency, provided an update to the City Planning Commission on the status of ReZone Syracuse. The update included changes to the proposed ordinance since 2019, updates since the Draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement was reviewed by the Common Council, and efforts to reach out to the public, the Advisory Committee, and the Common Council.

- VI. Public Hearings
 - <u>SP-21-02</u> (Continuation from 2/1/21 SK, RL, WB) Special Permit-Restaurant 1011-1013 Park Street Salat Muse (owner/applicant) Business, Class A

Mr. Bill Pitcher at 124 Feigel Avenue spoke to the City Planning Commission about the proposal, which consists of establishing a restaurant on property situated 1011-1013 Park Street. During the presentation, Mr. Pitcher presented a revised first-floor plan that replaced a previously-proposed dwelling unit with storage space for the proposed restaurant.

No one spoke in favor of or in opposition to the proposal.

After further discussion and review, the City Planning Commission agreed to continue the Public Hearing on April 5, 2021, in order to consider the revised proposal.

Mr. Brian Bouchard of CHA Consulting at 300 South State Street spoke to the City Planning Commission about the proposal, which consists of modifying the District Plan development standards for the JMA Planned Development District on properties situated at 1010, 1022, 1054, 1074 and 1080-1082 South Clinton Street, 222-224, 226, 228, and 232 Tallman Street, 1002-1022, and 1024-1040 South Salina Street, and 140 (aka 120-154) Cortland Avenue.
