

## RESOLUTION

A regular meeting of the City of Syracuse Industrial Development Agency was convened in public session on July 29, 2025 at 8:00 o'clock a.m., local time, in the Common Council Chambers, City Hall, 233 East Washington Street, Syracuse, New York.

The meeting was called to order by the Chair and upon the roll being duly called, the following members were:

The following resolution was offered by Dirk Sonneborn and seconded by Rickey T. Brown:

### RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING STAFF TO OBTAIN APPRAISALS ON CERTAIN PROPERTIES

**WHEREAS**, the City of Syracuse Industrial Development Agency (the “*Agency*”) is authorized and empowered by Title 1 of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York (the “*State*”), as amended, together with Chapter 641 of the Laws of 1979 of the State of New York, as amended from time to time (collectively, the “*Act*”), to promote, develop, encourage and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing of industrial, manufacturing, warehousing, commercial, research and recreation facilities, for the purpose of promoting economically sound commerce and industry to advance the job opportunities, health, general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of the State, to improve their recreation opportunities, prosperity and standard of living; and

**WHEREAS**, to accomplish its stated purposes, the Agency is authorized and empowered under the Act to grant “financial assistance” (as defined in the Act) in connection with the acquisition, reconstruction and equipping of one or more “projects” (as defined in the Act); and

**WHEREAS**, Agency staff is requesting authorization to obtain appraisals on certain real property owned by the Agency and located within the City of Syracuse, Onondaga County (the “*Properties*”) at a cost not to exceed \$3,600 (collectively, the “*Appraisals*”).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Agency that:

**Section 1.** The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein by reference. It is the policy of the State to promote the economic welfare, recreation opportunities and prosperity of its inhabitants and to actively promote, attract, encourage and develop recreation and

economically sound commerce and industry for the purpose of preventing unemployment and economic deterioration.

**Section 2.** It is among the purposes of the Agency to acquire real property, promote, develop, encourage and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing of certain facilities, including commercial facilities, and thereby advance the job opportunities, health, general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of the State and to improve their recreation opportunities, prosperity and standard of living. It is among the Agency's powers, to accomplish its purposes, to acquire by purchase or pursuant to the provisions of the eminent domain procedure law, or otherwise, and to use, real property or rights or easements therein necessary for its corporate purposes.

**Section 3.** The Agency hereby makes the following findings and determinations:

(a) The Agency is authorized to obtain Appraisals the Properties.

**Section 4.** The Chair, Vice Chair and/or Executive Director of the Agency are hereby authorized, empowered and directed, for and on behalf of the Agency, to perform any and all actions and to execute any and all documents on behalf of the Agency as they may deem necessary, appropriate or advisable to carry out the intent and purposes of the foregoing resolutions to obtain the Appraisals on the Properties..

**Section 5.** No covenant, stipulation, obligation or agreement contained in this resolution or any document referred to above shall be deemed to be the covenant, stipulation, obligation or agreement of any member, officer, agent or employee of the Agency in his or her individual capacity. Neither the members nor officers of the Agency, nor any person executing any documents referred to above on behalf of the Agency, shall be liable thereon or be subject to any personal liability or accountability by reason of the execution or delivery thereof.

**Section 6.** A copy of this Resolution shall be placed on file in the office of the Agency where the same shall be available for public inspection during business hours.

**Section 7.** This resolution shall take effect immediately.
