Application CA-26-03: A Certificate of Appropriateness application for exterior alterations at 300 Waverly Avenue, a local Protected Site. The property is owned by Syracuse University.

Application CA-26-04: A Certificate of Appropriateness application for exterior alterations at 334 Berkeley Drive, located in the Berkeley Park Preservation District. The property is owned by Reuben Levy and Yulya Truskinovsky.
