Artwork Description [include fabrication date; medium, dimensions, materials and finishes]: The proposed intersection enhancements project includes painted curb extensions (with vertical delineators and planter boxes) and an intersection mural. The mural is a paw print graphic, representing the Huntington Panthers. The location is adjacent to Huntington PK-8 School. The project will be installed by volunteers, coordinated by the Huntington School PTO, in August 2021. As recommended by City DPW, waterborne traffic marking paint will be used. The paint will be allowed to wear away over the winter, and the PTO will then work with the City to determine if the mural and/or curb extensions should be reinstalled, possibly with more durable materials.

Huntington Panthers Street Mural Project description

To increase safety of students and families and create a point of school and neighborhood pride, the Huntington School PTO has proposed enhancements to the Sunnycrest Road/Forest Hill Drive intersection, including a "Huntington Panthers Street Mural" as well as curb extensions around the existing crosswalks. The project will follow the principles of "tactical urbanism," which can be defined as "a city and/or citizen-led approach to neighborhood building using short-term, low-cost and scalable interventions to catalyze long-term change." Many tactical urbanism projects around the country focus on "placemaking" or reimagining road space to enhance the experience of bicyclists and pedestrians.

This project will use waterborne traffic marking paint as recommended by City of Syracuse DPW, moveable traffic delineator posts, and planters to clearly delineate pedestrian zones including curb extensions around the existing crosswalks in front of Huntington School. The project will also include a panther paw intersection mural (for the Huntington Panthers). The concept plan is attached, along with more detailed drawings of the mural. The PTO will recruit volunteers (PTO members and neighbors) to install the project in August 2021, prior to the start of the 2021-2022 school year (targeting August 8 with a rain date of August 15). A letter of support from the school principal is attached.

Total cost of the project is \$1,040. Huntington School PTO members approved \$200 for the purchase of plants at the February 11, 2021, meeting.¹ Eastwood TNT approved \$840 in Special Projects Funding for purchase of painting supplies, traffic delineators, and crates to hold plants at the February 22, 2021 meeting. A copy of the TNT award letter is attached.

This is intended to be a "semi-permanent" installation. The traffic delineators and plants will be removed in late fall, prior to the first snowfall. The waterborne traffic paint will be allowed to wear away over the winter. In the spring, the PTO will re-evaluate the project with City DPW and determine if the delineators and/or planters should be reinstalled, and if the curb extensions and mural should be repainted, possibly with more durable materials in the future. This is a typical approach to "tactical urbanism" projects.


