**Overview:** This license is required for public concert events in the City of Syracuse to ensure they operate in accordance with the law and do not endanger citizens' health, safety, and welfare. ### **License Requirements:**

- The property or business owner of the space where the event is being held must apply.
- The license must be issued per event. Each event must have its own application.
- The application must be submitted at least 14 days before the event.
- A City review must be conducted before the license is issued.
- Premises must comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations to protect public health and safety. The applicant must keep good order and sufficient police force, at their expense, at the premise during the event.
- The applicant must ensure proper exits and keep passageways and stairs from such exits adequately lit.
- All outdoor entertainment must cease at 10 p.m.
- Certificate must be posted conspicuously in window or door during the event.

Completed Concert License Application (pages 2 to 3). The application must be signed in the presence of a
notary public.
\$15 Application Fee. Check or Money Order payable to Commissioner of Finance.
Copy of Applicant's Photo Identification: Driver's License, Passport, or equivalent.

- 1. Application must be completed in its entirety. Incomplete applications will not be processed.
