Professional Basketball and Hockey License Instructions

Overview: This license is required for professional basketball or hockey events. The license ensures the event operates in accordance with the law and does not endanger citizens' health, safety, and welfare. It also ensures police and fire personnel have been notified of the event. For more information, <u>click here to read the Ordinance</u>.

License Requirements:

- The property or business owner of the space where the event is being held must apply.
- The license can be issued and renewed every year or issued as a one-day license. If you are paying the yearly fee, you must file an application for each event occurring throughout the year.
- The application must be submitted at least 14 days before the event.
- A City review must be conducted before the license is issued.
- Premises must comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations to protect public health and safety. The applicant must keep good order and sufficient police force, at their expense, at the premise during the event.
- The applicant must ensure proper exits and keep passageways and stairs from such exits adequately lit.
- Certificate must be posted conspicuously on window or door during the event.

Application Checklist:

- □ Completed Professional Basketball and Hockey License Application (pages 2 to 3). Application must be signed in the presence of a notary public.
- □ Application Fee (\$25 Per Event or \$100 Per Year). Check or Money Order payable to Commissioner of Finance.
- □ Copy of Applicant's Photo Identification: Driver's License, Passport, or equivalent.

Submittal Instructions:

- 1. Application must be completed in its entirety. Incomplete applications will not be processed.
